There's a phrase in Isaiah 61:2 that is repeated in the Gospel of Luke, a call to "proclaim the year of the Lord's favor and... comfort all who mourn." I find myself repeating these ancient words to myself as I consider what this year, and this month, will be like for us as a faith community. We have nearly completed two years living within a global pandemic; at times I want to scream that this is not fair and I would like a better gift for us all, perhaps peace or an end to climate change, or a more equitable distribution of resources.

And yet the ancient voice of wisdom calls to me, calls to our community of faith to remember how God has been faithful to us these past years, these many years, all of the years.

The scriptures ask us to reach to our spiritual centers for the strength to offer comfort to those who mourn, and in doing so to lift up the promise of the blessings we find each day even in the midst of the unknown and unwished-for.

We are reassured time and again that we will find wisdom to claim and share when we join the prophets in proclaiming that this year, this month, this day - each moment belongs to God and carries with it the hope of resurrection.

This year February leads us directly towards Lent, with plenty of time to practice the discipline of proclamation - how will we share the good news of God's presence in our lives? How will we comfort those who mourn? I've made a short list; I am confident you can think of additional options as we move through this month of blessings and wisdom.

what's with all the green?

Green is the standard color for "Ordinary Time," the stretches of time between Easter and Christmas, and Christmas and Lent. It is meant to represent **the anticipation and hope in the resurrection of Christ**.

Green symbolizes the hope and life of each new day.




FEBRUARY FOCUS: ON THE ROAD TO EASTER

The Christian Year calendar is our guide for worship and faith formation. It has two major cycles: the Advent-Christmas-Epiphany cycle (ending **February 27 with Transfiguration Day**) and the Lent-Easter-Pentecost cycle (in which we celebrate **Easter April 17**.) In the three-year process of reading Scripture, we find ourselves in "Year C," focusing heavily on the Gospel accountings of Luke.

From the blasts of the shofar reminding us to heed the warning call and turn our lives around (repent), the imposition of the ashes on our hand or head, our observance of **Ash Wednesday, March 2** is a tradition for Saint Paul with a 7:00 PM worship service.

February is also **Black History month**, and, as has been our tradition for over 25 hears, a wide variety of culturally appropriate music will be offered in worship during both PianoSide and our sanctuary service each week. We are appreciative of the ministry through music of the volunteers and friends that bring meaning and encouragement to each service.
