

The coming of the Messiah according to the Apostle Mark...that is what will guide our worship during this Advent 2023. The Sacrament of Holy Communion will be celebrated December 02/03, the first weekend of Advent. The second weekend of Advent, December 09/10, will be graced by music of our faithful Joy Bells ensemble. December 16/17, the third Advent weekend, will graced by the Children's Ministries re-enactment of the Luke passage telling of Christ's birth, as part of 10:00 worship. Any who find themselves suffering in body, mind or spirit are invited to join as we observe a service of Blue Christmas worship Wednesday evening, December 13 at 7:00 p.m. in the Roth Chapel. Christmas Eve weekend will begin with the traditional setting of Advent Lessons and Carols celebrated as we observe the 4th weekend of Advent with December 23 Chapel worship at 5:00 p.m. and the Sunday service at 10:00 a.m. with the Solid Brass and David Schack, organist. Later that same day we gather to celebrate Christmas Eve, with a single service of candles, carols, and communion all in the beauty of the St. Paul Sanctuary. The 7:30 worship will include the singing of Malotte's "The Lord's Prayer" as led by The Choir. This rich tradition was established as collaboration between the Rev. Dr. Alva Clark and the Honorable Judge Walter Cropper in 1953. It will be the 70th consecutive year the beautiful melody has graced our worship. Finally, in biding "auld lang syne" to 2023, we will keep Wesley's "Watch Night" observance in Roth Chapel Saturday evening, December 30 at 5:00 p.m. 2024 will be welcomed with the first Sunday service of the year, December 31, where we celebrate the Wesleyan covenant with the Sacrament of Holy Communion. At this year's end, we give thanks for the dedication and vibrant leadership offered by the many volunteers who grace the Music Ministry of St. Paul Church. Your perseverance and commitment make worship a true blessing from God!
