

inWorship Haly Week Ends

**Good Friday, March 29:** For Protestants the observance of Good Friday is a most somber and solemn occasion. This powerful retelling of Christ's last hours will begin @ 7 p.m. in the Sanctuary. Our worship will center round the power of the cross as we hear the words of the Saint Paul Youth bring the story of Peter's witness to the crucifixion to life.

Holy Saturday, March 30: We begin our time of worship with a reminder that Christ has not yet risen. The sacrament of Holy Communion offers us the chance to start anew in God's love for us as Christ's resurrection is announced. The service will begin at 5:00 p.m. in Roth Chapel.

**Easter Day, March 31:** Easter Sunday is the main reason why Christians keep Sunday, the first day of the week, as the primary day of religious observance. Easter serves as the great feast day and pinnacle of the Christian liturgical year. It is also the first day of the new season of the Great Fifty Days, or Eastertide, which runs from Easter Sunday to Pentecost Sunday. Our celebration of the empty tomb will include the Sacrament of Holy Communion. Guest organist, David Schack, will offer a thrilling 15-minute prelude before the Sanctuary service at 10:00 a.m. The Choir and Joy Bells will also lead in worship. Bring your family and friends to celebrate at St. Paul.

Worship during the month of April will be enhanced by the presence of our House Band on **April 20** and the Joy Bells **April 26/27**.


During the second week of April, I am looking forward to attending the online version of the Five-Day Academy for Spiritual Formation. Listen for stories related to the experience during upcoming sermons.


